Venue information

The 12th annual Dieback Information Conference will be held at the state library of Western Australia on Friday 28th of June.

Time: Please arrive prior to 8:30am for an 8:30 am start. The conference will finish at 4:30pm.

Location: Library located between James St, William St and Francis St in Northbridge.

Parking: There is parking beneath the Library accessible from Francis St and another car park nearby accessible from Roe St. The theatre where the conference will be held is on your left as you enter the library through the Francis St entrance. ***only the Francis St entrance will be open in the morning.**

Public Transport: Public transport is a great option for those not wishing to battle with the traffic and parking hassles. There are bus stops very close by on William St and Beaufort St and the Perth Train Station is a short walk away.



Please get your name checked off upon entry to the theatre foyer on the morning of the conference. Collect a name tag from the registration desk. Tickets can be purchased on the day if seats are available – cash only.
